Visual Supports

- Supports the understanding and expression of verbal language
 - Gives hints about word meanings
 - Helps with focus
 - Helps with organization
 - Permanent so gives time to think about it
 - Helps behavior
 - Help child appreciate the importance of written language


- This book was used in conjunction with the real toy.
